Federal Funding Available to Replace Diesel School Buses

School districts can now apply for federal funding to replace diesel school buses with low-emissions alternatives – like propane autogas – over the next five years.

Take steps now to ensure local districts in your area know about the Environmental Protection Agency's \$5 billion Clean School Bus Program funding and that propane buses are eligible.

The program will help pay to swap existing buses with cleaner models that result in better air quality on the bus, in bus loading areas, and throughout the communities that they serve.

The maximum rebate amount per bus varies by fuel type, bus size, and whether the applying school district meets one or more priorities. They include rural school districts and those having 20 percent or more students living in poverty.

Propane autogas models serving prioritized districts qualify for up to \$25,000 per vehicle. Those serving districts that are not prioritized are eligible for up to \$15,000. Each school district may request funds to replace up to 25 buses.

Fleets must replace old buses by the end of the project period, but there can be overlap between receiving new buses and replacing old ones.

Deadline for submitting applications for the first year of funding is Aug. 19.

Propane Incentives Reduce Emissions and Reward Builders

PERC's 2021 Propane Construction Incentive Program, which awarded \$1.25 million to builders and remodelers for installing qualifying high-efficiency propane appliances, helped eliminate an estimated 7 million pounds of carbon dioxide in 950 homes across 33 states.

"Eliminating 7 million pounds of carbon dioxide is a huge win for the planet," said Bryan Cordill, director of residential and commercial business development at PERC.

"Many people believe electricity is the 'clean' answer to reducing carbon emissions. But electrifying everything is not the answer. It will take decades and cost trillions of dollars. Not to mention most U.S. grid electricity is produced by burning natural gas or coal. Propane is an immediate solution to accelerate decarbonization, and the findings from last year's program show that impact."

The Propane Construction Incentive Program encourages builders and remodelers to install

more propane appliances in new and existing home construction. The program offers a baseline incentive of up to \$1,000 to builders or remodelers who upgrade to propane appliances in a new build or a remodel.

Take the Propane Safety Message to Your Forklift Customers

The material handling industry recognizes June 14 as National Forklift Safety Day, a time they emphasize the importance of worker safety in all aspects of forklift operations.

Most equipment operators depend on the expert guidance of their propane supplier to ensure they are safely handling the propane that powers their business. "It's important to keep our material handling customers safe all year long, but June is a great opportunity to tell them all they need to know about forklift safety and share resources that PERC has developed to keep them and their employees safe," says Eric Kuster, vice president of safety, education, and compliance for the Propane Education & Research Council.

"Whether teaching new employees or reminding seasoned veterans, your expert guidance in the safe storage, use and filling of cylinders can prevent accidents and incidents."

Topics Kuster recommends reviewing with forklift customers include:

- Proper position of the pressure relief valve
- Opening service valves slowly and checking for leaking valves
- Storage of cylinders in properly located cages
- Wearing protective gloves and eyewear
- Cylinder inspections for dangerous rust, dents or cracks in welds
- Inspection for wear or damage to O-rings, hoses, and fittings
- Ensuring that cylinders are within requalification date
- Check for propane leaks in cylinder

Take some time next month to visit or call your forklift customers. Start the conversation with PERC's free videos, posters, handouts and more and share the safety resources compiled on the Forklift Safety landing page at propane.com/propane-forklift-safety.

They include:

- **PowerPoint Presentation:** Encourage your customers to use it during safety meetings to walk through reminders for workers. Better yet,

attend one of your customer's safety meetings in June and walk through these reminders with them.

- **Poster:** Send this poster to your customers and encourage them to put it in a high-traffic area to remind everyone about essential safety tips for forklifts.
- **Safety Handout:** Have your customers distribute this to their entire crew for quick reference.
- **Videos:** Use these quick animations on your website or social channels.
